**ITEM 19
FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE REPRESENTATIONS**

The FTC’s Franchise Rule permits a franchisor to disclose information about the actual or potential financial performance of its franchised and/or franchisor-owned outlets if there is a reasonable basis for the information, and if the information is included in this disclosure document. Financial performance information that differs from any included in Item 19 may be given only if: (1) a franchisor provides the actual records of an existing outlet that you are considering buying; or (2) a franchisor supplements the information provided in this Item 19, for example, by providing information about possible performance at a particular location or under particular circumstances.

On December 31, 2025 we had 42 Franchises in operation. Of those, 40 Franchises have been operating their Franchises for at least one year (“Reporting Group”). We divided the Reporting Group into four separate subgroups: (a) franchisees in the top quartile of all Gross Sales (10 franchisees) (“Group One”); (b) franchisees in the second quartile of all Gross Sales (10 franchisees) (“Group Two”); (c) franchisees in the third quartile of all Gross Sales (10 franchisees) (“Group Three”); and (d) franchisees in the bottom quartile of all Gross Sales (10 franchisees) (“Group Four”). The information in all four tables below is based on Gross Sales reports submitted to us by the Reporting Group.

Notes:

1. We are not aware of any material differences between the franchise businesses operated by the Reporting Group and the franchise business described in this Disclosure Document.
2. The Gross Sales figures represent revenues for all services and products sold by a Drama Kids Business. Gross Sales does not include taxes paid, refunds, allowances or discounts.
3. The financial performance representations in this Item 19 do not reflect the costs of sales, operating expenses, or other costs or expenses that must be deducted from the gross revenue or gross sales figures to obtain your net income or profit. These include cost of sales, payroll, and related expenses, rent, office expenses, other expenses, amortization, depreciation, income taxes or other taxes, or debt service obligations. You should conduct an independent investigation of the costs and expenses you will incur in operating your franchised business. Franchisees or former franchisees, listed in the Disclosure Document, may be one source of this information.
4. The numerical average is calculated by dividing the respective Gross Sales by the number of franchise owners in each group. Of the 10 franchise owners in Group One, three exceeded the Gross Sales average (30%). Of the 10 franchise owners in Group Two, five exceeded the Gross Sales average (50%). Of the 10 franchise owners in Group Three, five exceeded the Gross Sales average (50%). Of the 10 franchise owners in Group Four, five exceeded the Gross Sales average



(50%).
